### **Casual Pool Attendant**

Wylie's Baths, one of Sydney's most beloved ocean pools, is seeking a dynamic and enthusiastic **Casual Pool Attendant** to join our team. The primary focus of the Pool Attendant is the safety, security, and wellbeing of people in the pool and its surrounds. The additional focus is to assist in the kiosk/gate/general facility operations, maintenance, and execution of our COVID Safety Plan.

#### **Reporting directly to the Day Manager while on shift (and also to the Baths Manager & The Wylie's Baths Trust, generally) your role will include:**

- Observation and monitoring of pool users
- Lifesaving and first aid duties
- Poolside pressure cleaning, bluebottle removal, marine growth & sea urchin removal
- Undertaking incidental basic facility maintenance functions
- Ensuring the consistent high level of cleanliness and hygiene for all patrons of the Baths, including swimmers and non-swimmers. This includes cleaning changerooms & bathrooms, kiosk kitchen area, and grounds maintenance.
- Checking and maintenance of all lifesaving and first aid equipment

Ideally you will be an active member of a Surf Lifesaving Club; or have had prior volunteer or professional pool/ocean lifeguarding experience with the following qualifications and essential criteria;

#### **Required Qualifications & Essential Criteria:**

- Bronze Medallion or Royal Lifesaving Pool Lifeguard; including HLTAID003 Provide first aid (now HLTAID011)
- Advanced Resuscitation Techniques (or equivalent) including the following topics:
  - o Advanced resuscitation techniques
  - o Spinal management
  - o Defibrillation
- Availability to work Fridays, Saturday, Sunday & public holidays as part of a 365 day roster
- Availability to work through the week during summer school holidays
- Required to have two doses of a Covid-19 vaccination
- Required to complete an in-house induction/skills check to confirm practical lifesaving skills & ability

#### **Skills & Experience:**

- Lifeguard / pool management experience in the pool / surf / recreation industry (ie public facilities or beaches)
- An understanding of safety management processes in an exposed, open water environment
- Understanding of hazard identification, risk control, and harm prevention strategies
- Strong people management and public relations / communications skills

#### **Additional Desired Qualifications:**

- Food safety / hygiene
- Barista experience
- Point of sale technology
